

- **£7,000** to adapt a bathroom for a soldier who lost a leg when his vehicle hit a roadside bomb in Iraq. The soldier, who was badly traumatized, required a level access shower with a seat and hand rails, plus sliding doors to his bathroom.
- **£5,000** to provide a therapeutic pool and furniture for a soldier badly injured by a roadside bomb in Afghanistan. The soldier suffered 70% burns and required hydrotherapy and leather furniture appropriate for his severely injured skin.
- **£1,500** towards taking a group of injured soldiers from Hedley Court to see the Grand Prix.
- **£10,000** to provide specialist vocational assessment for injured soldiers. The ability to support their families is very important to most soldiers, including the injured. Establishing realistic career goals to focus on can greatly assist both mental and physical recovery.
- **£10,000** to provide decompression facilities for soldiers returning from operations in Afghanistan. Soldiers are often under extreme, prolonged stress whilst at war. A brief period of 'cooling down' in Cypress makes it easier to re-adjust to civilian and family life.
- **£10,000** to provide activity holidays for the families of soldiers killed in Afghanistan and Iraq. The breaks involve outdoor activities such horse-riding, abseiling and archery and allow bereaved families to meet and support each other.
